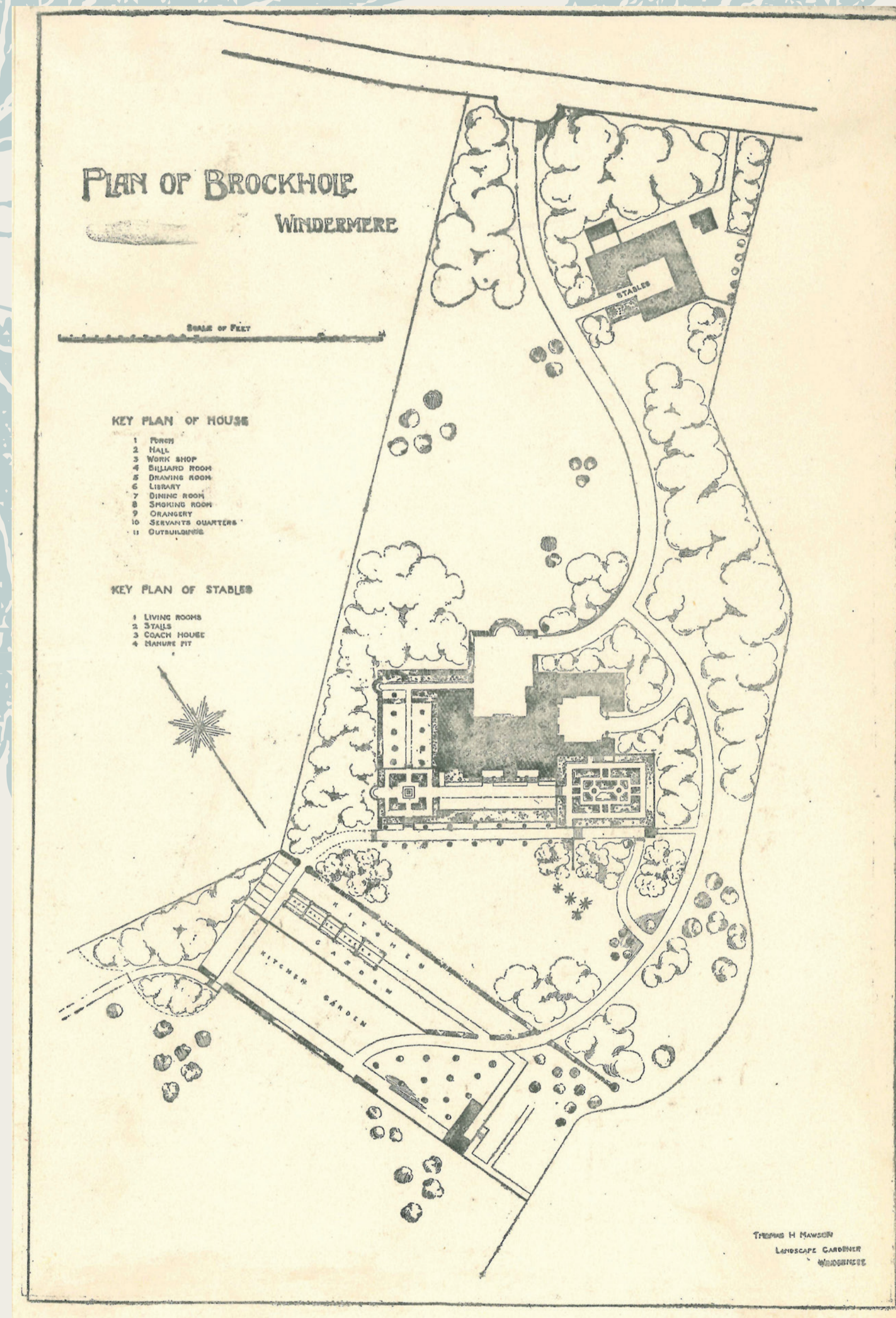


Garden of earthly delights

A GARDEN OF
MAWSON'S MAKING
OF ITS TIME, TIMELESS

The kitchen garden here has produced fruit and vegetables for over a hundred years. It is still used today.

The kitchen garden was designed by landscape gardener Thomas Mawson in 1899, for its owner William Gaddum. The kitchen garden has been remodelled and rebuilt a few times since then. Today it grows produce for Brockhole's restaurant and café.



The original working plan drawn by Thomas Mawson is different to early photographs. The curved stone walls and clearly separated plots reflected Mawson's expert approach to garden design.



Seen from above, the kitchen garden today is smaller than it was in 1899. Please take a look around.
